POLAR BEAR AWARD

Camp in the snow...and like it! That's the theme of this award. Any registered Scout or Explorer, provided their leader feels that they have sufficient camping experience and training in winter camping, is eligible. The requirements of the Polar Bear Award are:

- 1) Participate in an overnight campout at one of our camps or other camping area during the winter when the air temperature is 20°F or below during that night.
- 2) During the overnight campout, sleep in a small tent, tarp, lean-to, or improvised shelter, and cook at least three meals outdoors.
- 3) Adult leadership must be in camp when the Scouts qualify, and are responsible for their safety and welfare.
- 4) Have the Campmaster or Ranger certify completion below, if available. If not, the troop adult leader may sign.
