**#3: Half Time Show:** Pack Pizazz: running Pack meetings and Pack events

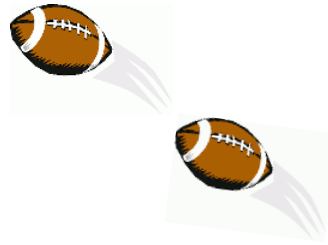
**#4: Field Goal:** Neckerchief slide and craft fun; make something to take home!
