


Welcome to Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO)!!!

Enclosed below are the instructions to access and complete the on-line portion of the BALOO Training.


Step 1: Open an Internet browser (e.g., Internet Explorer, Chrome) and go to: my.scouting.org




Step 2: Log into your my.scouting account with your username / password. If you do not have an account, please create one and then log in the system. Upon successful login, you should see the following:



Step 3: In the top left corner, click on 'Menu >' and select 'My Dashboard'. This displays the 'My Training' menu:

Step 10: Select the first title, BALOO introduction, to launch the online training module. Upon completion, you should be returned to the BALOO Prerequisite Training page showing the first module completed. If not, please use the above steps to return to the menu page to access the remaining modules. Select the next module in the Learning Plan until all 8 modules have been completed.

Once a module has been completed, you may leave and return at a later time to complete the remaining modules.
